## **Overview**

He completed his MBBS and MS in Gujarat, followed by MCh and DNB in Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery from CMC Vellore. Dr. Ludhani further enhanced his expertise through **international fellowships in Advanced Adult Cardiac Surgery** at the Royal Melbourne Hospital and in Heart-Lung Transplantation and MCS at St. Vincent's Hospital, Sydney.

After returning to India, Dr. Ludhani played a pivotal role in developing heart transplant programs at leading institutions including U. N. Mehta Institute (Ahmedabad), MIOT International (Chennai), MGM Hospital (Chennai), and Sparsh Hospitals (Bengaluru).

He has been honored with **the prestigious G.C. Sharma Fellowship by the IACTS** and received an award for academic excellence from the Chief Minister of Gujarat.

Deeply committed to advancing academic research, Dr. Ludhani has contributed to national and international journals and serves as a reviewer for the Annals of Thoracic Surgery. His clinical interests include heart and lung transplantation, and circulatory assist devices.
