Rheumatologists treat these, plus systemic autoimmune disorders, unexplained fevers, and rashes.

10. Does a rheumatologist treat bone cancer?

No, rheumatologists specialize in non-surgical treatments of joint diseases. Orthopedic oncology surgeons are the specialists for bone cancer treatment.
