8. When should I consult a cardiologist?

Consult a cardiologist if you experience chest pain, dizziness, palpitations, or shortness of breath; have high blood pressure, chronic kidney disease, or peripheral artery disease; have a history of smoking or diabetes; or have a family history of high cholesterol or heart disease. A sedentary lifestyle also warrants a consultation.

9. What to expect at my first visit to a heart specialist?

Your initial consultation with a cardiologist will involve a thorough review of your medical history and risk factors for coronary artery disease. Expect a physical examination focusing on your cardiovascular system, including heart rate and blood pressure measurements. An electrocardiogram may also be performed.

10. How do cardiologists diagnose blocked arteries?

Cardiologists utilize various diagnostic tests to identify arterial blockages. These may include: angiography, echocardiography (often with a stress test), electrocardiogram (ECG), chest X-ray, ultrasound, computed tomography (CT) scan, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scan, positron emission tomography (PET) scan, and cholesterol blood tests (lipid profile).

11. Can I see a cardiologist directly?

Depending on your insurance coverage, a referral from your primary care physician may be necessary. However, if you have concerns about heart health, a direct consultation with a cardiologist is often possible.
